Proposals should be education-oriented. Preference will be given towards new or less experienced programs and proposals that impact the greatest number of students. You must be a TJEA member to apply.

Number of Grants Awarded Per Year: 10 (5 high school;  
5 elementary/middle/intermediate)

Maximum Award: \$250

Additional Grants: Programs are only eligible for one grant every three years.
